For Further Study

(Please use on your own, with a friend, or in your small group.)

1. What does the word “glory” mean to you when you use it or hear it being used in everyday language and conversation?
2. Has the biblical definition of “glory,” and the way Pastor Mark described it changed your view on the “glory of God/Christ”? If so, how?
3. Read John 2.1-11. What happened when Jesus “manifested His glory”?
4. Read John 8.54. Does Jesus glorify Himself? Who glorifies Jesus? What example or model is Jesus giving to us here?
5. Read John 11.1-46. Pay close attention to what Jesus says in verses 4 and 40. What do you learn about the glory of God in the true story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead?
6. Read the remainder of the Book of John. Every time you read the word “glory” write down the verse. What do you notice about how “glory” is used in those verses? If you want to go further, read Romans, 2 Corinthians, and 2 Peter and note how many times “glory” is used and how it is used.
