2. Think about Christ's grace and truth. Which one do you tend to emphasize in your life and/or in telling others about Jesus. Why do you emphasize grace or truth? How has Pastor Mark's sermon helped you to re-think that?
3. Have you ever felt condemned? How does Romans 8.1 help you to re-think condemnation? Talk to Jesus about this in prayer. If you are not a Christian, then invite Jesus to deliver you from condemnation by believing in Him by faith. If you are a Christian, then ask Jesus to take away your constant feeling of being condemned.
4. Prepare for Christmas this week by reading the story of the birth of Jesus in Luke 2. As you read, highlight what impacts you. Now, read it again. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you as read and think about this amazing true story that's full of such hope and promise?
