1. As you listened to this week's sermon and read the Scripture passages, what were you convicted about? What do you believe the Holy Spirit has said to you through the Word of God? Write this down.
2. Pastor Mark believes God rules over sin and can use sin to strengthen His people against temptation. Do you agree? Disagree? Re-read 1 Corinthians 10.13 and discuss with your small group or with a friend. Contemplate this in your own life.
3. Pastor Mark has also found that God rules over sin and can use sin to preserve His own people. Read Genesis 50, and particularly verse 20.
4. Pastor Mark has also found that God rules over sin and can use sin to test His own people. Read Job 1.11-12 and then either by continuing your reading in Job or based on what you know about the rest of the Book of Job, determine if this is true.
5. Pastor Mark has also found that God rules over sin and can use sin to glorify Himself. Read Exodus 7.3 and Romans 9.17. Do you see this?
6. Some people object to sin being a problem. In response to the Genesis story have you heard someone say, "What's the big deal? It's just a piece of fruit." How would you answer such a comment?
