4. Do you believe God has the power to make a Christian out of someone who is persecuting His church today? If so, spend some time in prayer asking the Lord to bring His salvation from sin to people who are currently persecuting and killing Christians. Pray for the safety of our brothers and sisters in Christ who are facing injustice, even in our nation of China!
5. Read Philippians 3.1-11. What do you learn about the Apostle Paul from this letter to the church at Philippi?
