As the situation in Hong Kong continues to develop, the leaders of the church would like to call the EEC community into a time of intentional prayer and fasting for the city. God commands his people to pray for the well-being and peace of the places where they live (Jer. 29:7). We are to love and care for the people in our city, because God loves them. Our love for people starts with prayer, and we are to pray for the things that God desires.

To help us maintain a right focus and attitude in prayer, a prayer guide has been created that will be made available weekly. The prayer guide will take the congregation through four main areas:
